RULES & CONSTITUTION OF EXMOOR FOREST SCHOOL

1. THE NAME OF THE ASSOCIATION IS: EXMOOR FOREST SCHOOL

2. AIMS & OBJECTIVES OF THE ASSOCIATION:

- 1) To promote the holistic development of all involved, fostering resilient, confident, independent and creative learners for young people of the Exmoor area.
- 2) To learn to cooperate and work with their peers and adults and to develop strategies in order to take risks within the boundaries of safety.
- 3) Forest School is about exploring and experiencing the natural world through practical activities. The children go out in all weathers, all year round, exploring and learning from the seasons and environment changes. Appropriate clothing will be worn and during high winds it will be considered unsafe to go into the woods. The children's interests along with the varied natural resources in our woodland are used to stimulate creative thinking, problem solving and skill development.
